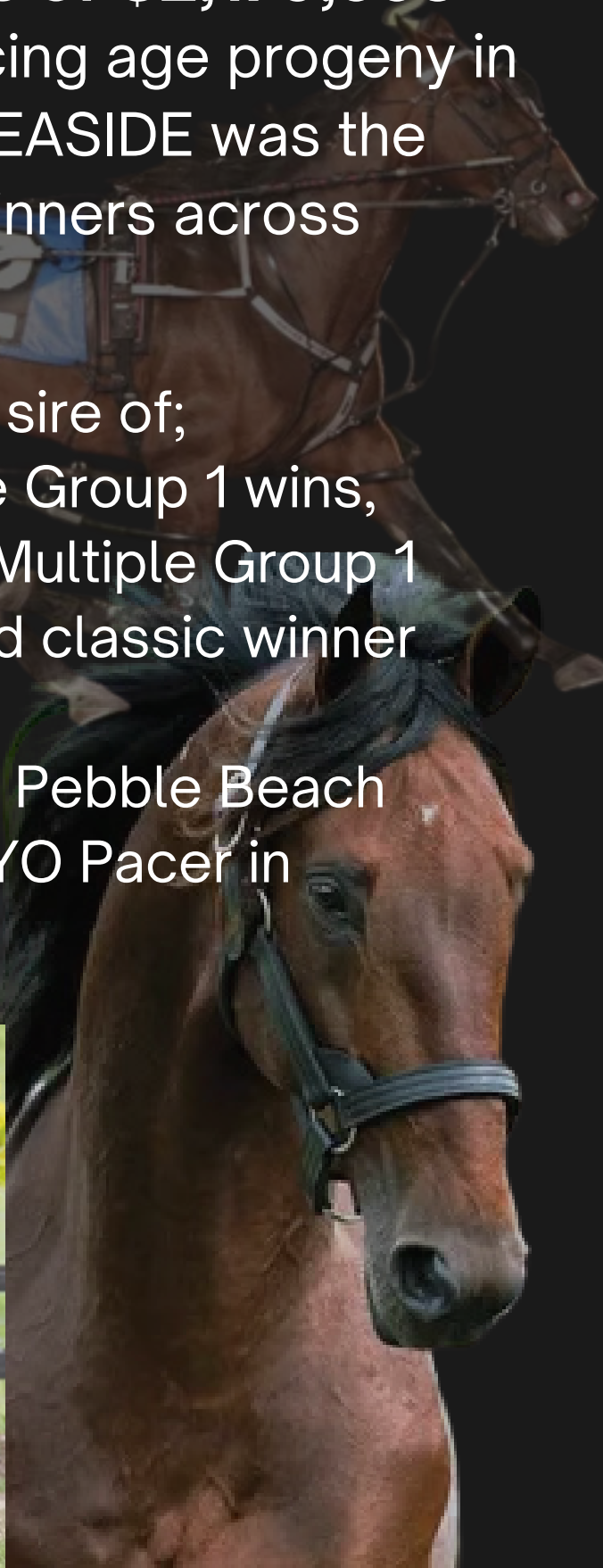

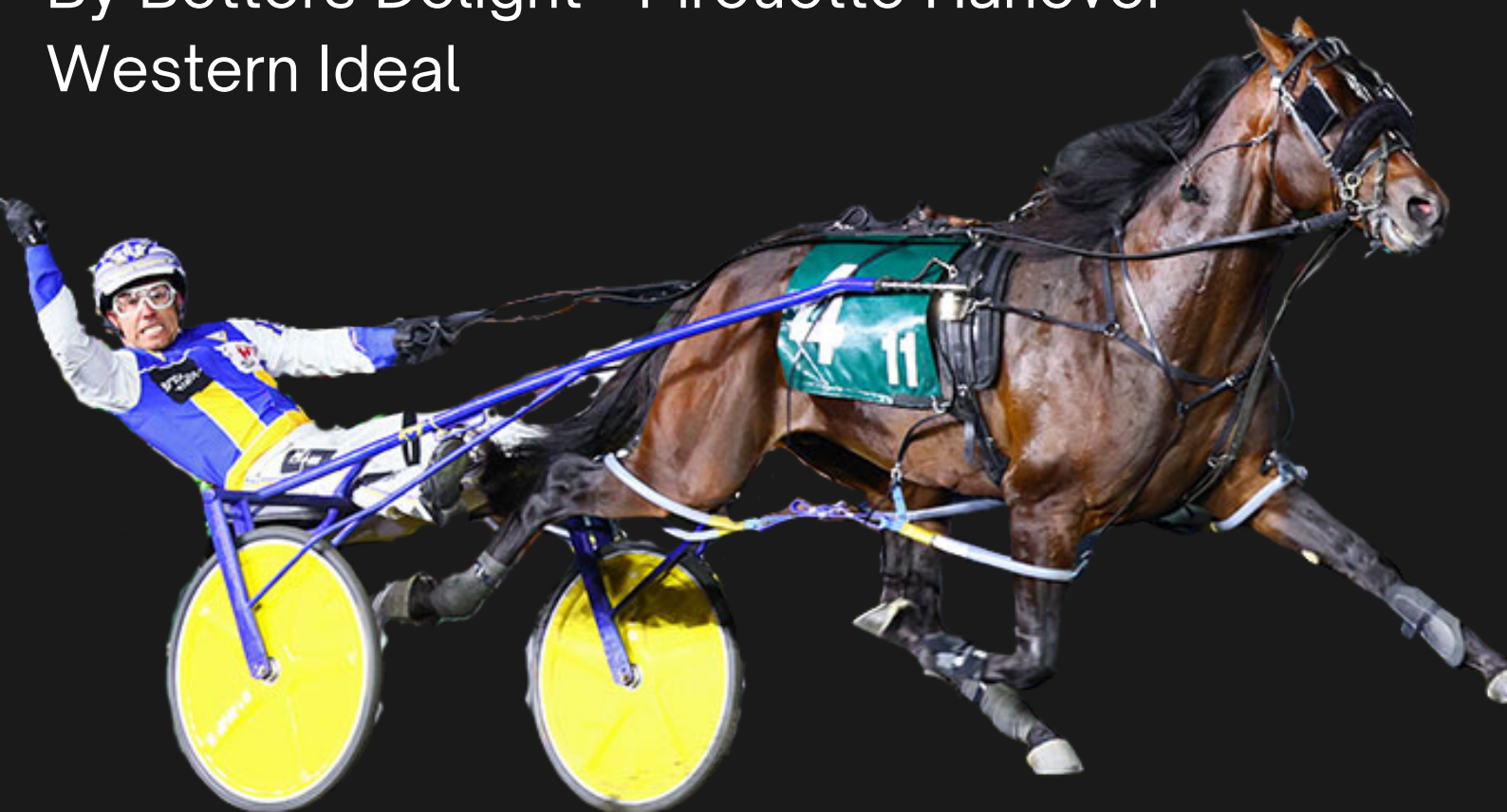

POSTER BOY

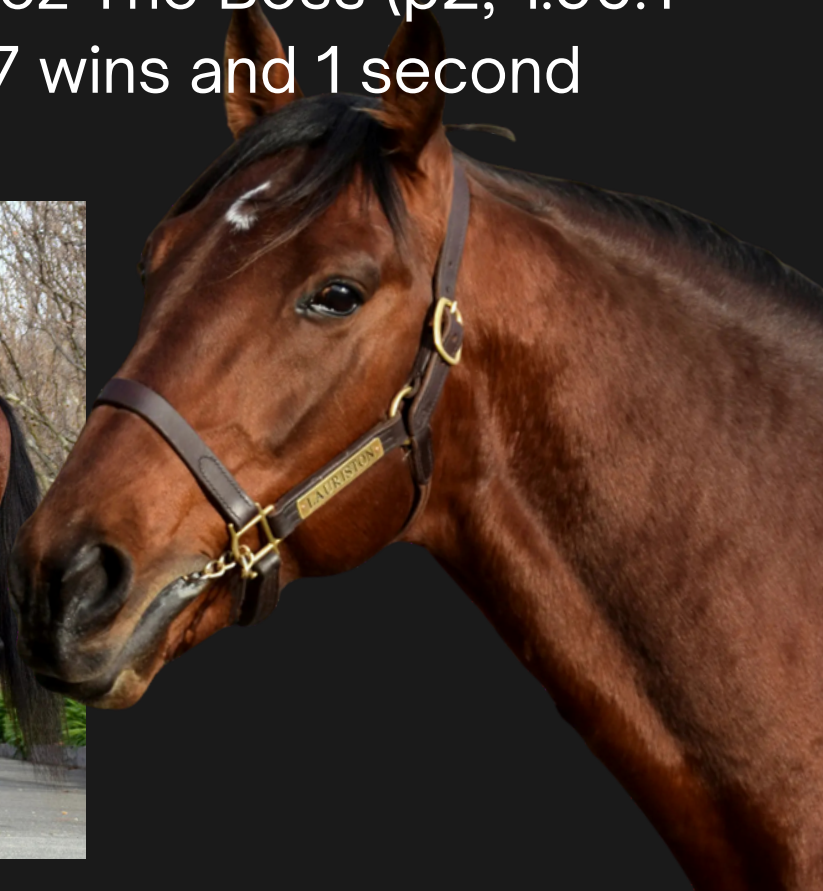


1.49.1 MR, 22 wins and \$803,310 in earnings
